Construction of 44 km route with flyover will save time and fuels of people

**Sarkhej- Gandhinagar highway to be made six-lane
at cost of Rs. 750 Crore: Nitinbhai Patel**

Gandhinagar, Wednesday: Deputy Chief Minister Mr. Nitinbhai Patel said that Sarkhej – Gandhinagar highway (SG highway) one which connects Ahmedabad city with Gandhinagar the capital of the State will be converted into six-lane road at a cost of Rs. 750 crore. A proposal for six-lane conversion of SG highway was sent to Central Government by the State Government with a view to increasing traffic, which has been approved today, he added.

He said that six-laning of this 44 km highway stretch will result into reduction in traffic and will save time and fuel of the people. Under the proposed project, flyovers will be built at Pakwan, Viashnodevi circle, Sargasan, Sanand and Infocity junction. Moreover the over bridge situated at Sola will be widened to six-lane.
