State Government's Pro-employee decision

**33 board and corporation employees to be benefitted with
7th Pay Commission: Deputy CM**

Gandhinagar, Wednesday: Deputy Chief Minister Mr. Nitinbhai Patel announced that the Central government has decided to give benefits of the 7th Pay Commission to the officials and employees. Gujarat has been the first state to implement the decision and initiate the process of the same. 92,092 employees and officials of the 33 boards and corporations functioning across the state which are not being provided any grant from the state government and which run on their own treasury shall receive the benefit of the same and it shall put an additional burden worth Rs. 377 crores to the state government.

It is worth to mention here that out of 33 boards and corporations which have certain settlements with the worker unions shall implement the rules of the 7th Pay Commission upon completion of the same.

He also added that there are 84,967 employees of G.S.R.T.C and Gujarat Electricity Board whose salary scales are decided separately, through an award. In such a scenario, they shall be able to receive the benefits of the 7th Pay Commission once their period of the previous settlement ends.
